NJDOT Releases Draft Capital Plan for Fiscal Year 2025

NJDOT has published their DRAFT Capital program for Fiscal Year 2025 which begins on July 1,2024. The Draft program becomes final after consideration by the State Legislature as part of theFiscalYear2025StateBudgetprocess.

The FY2025 proposes a \$4.859 overall Capital Program which includes \$3.18 billion for NJDOT and\$1.679 Billion for NJ Transit.\$2.79 Billion of the program comes from Federal funding with \$1.947billiontowardsNJDOTand\$842milliontoNJTransit.

The program provides funding across a number of broad categories including:

- \$1.35 billion for State & Local Bridges
- \$478 million for Pavement Rehabilitation, Renovation & Resurfacing
- \$153 million for Safety Improvements
- \$252 million to address Highway Congestion
- \$729 million for Local Support which includes \$400 million for the State Local Aid Program
