NJDOT Projects \$1.1 Billion in Contract Awards for FY2025

NJDOT has awarded 25 contracts for \$164 million thus far in Fiscal Year 2025. This includes 7 Paving Contracts with a value of \$67 million representing 170,000 tons of asphalt awarded. For Fiscal 2024 as of the same date, NJDOT had awarded 24 contracts with a value of \$342 million which include 15 paving contracts with a value of \$76 million. It should be noted that NJDOT has accepted bids this year in excess of \$200 million for contracts which have not yet been awarded. The asphalt tonnage year to date for FY2025 is almost exactly the same as FY2024 year to date which is just over 170,000.

NJDOT is projecting an overall Fiscal Year 2025 Capital Program of \$1.1 Billion which includes 37 paving projects valued at more than \$360 million. NJDOT plans to provide some treatment to 949 lane miles during FY2025.

Tilcon representatives discussed the regulatory challenges faced by our industry as well as the continued need for investment in infrastructure and the need to continue pursuing options for the responsible use of reclaimed asphalt.
